With the Arizona Credit for Donations made to Qualifying Charitable Organizations (formerly AZ Working Poor Tax Credit)

Under the Arizona Charitable Tax Credit Law (ARS 43-1088) for charities focusing on help for the working poor, you can now contribute up to \$800 for couples filing jointly (\$400 for individuals) to support Dysart Community Center in its important mission, and your generous gift will normally cost you nothing. All donations received will be used to underwrite essential services for low income children and adults.

How it Works

Your donation to Dysart Community Center	- \$800
Your Arizona, \$ for \$, tax credit received	<u>+ \$800</u>
Your Arizona net cost of support	\$0
Federal tax deduction received (at 25%)	<u>+ \$200</u>
Your net combined tax result	+ \$200

How to Participate:

1. Donate up to \$800 for couples filing jointly (\$400 for individuals) by December 31. **Importantly, this can be in addition to any donation you may give to Arizona Public Schools.**
2. Submit the simple AZ Tax Credit Form 321 when you file your Arizona Income Tax Return. This tax form is available online, but one can be mailed to you upon request. For most, your state income tax will be reduced by the amount of your donation up to \$800.
3. In addition, you can include your donation among your charitable contributions in filing your Federal Tax Return. Your Federal tax may be reduced by up to another \$200 (in 25% tax bracket).
